Norwood was Barb's home for nearly 80 years, she moved to the village from the town of Brickley with her parents and sister in 1942. However there was always a connection to the village as her father Arthur Davey was born and raised in Dummer and her mother Roxie Golloher was originally from Norwood. In 1953 Barb married a local boy named Jack Bitten and by the early 1960s they had built a house beside her parents. From their home Jack operated Bitten Motors and Barb started her own hair salon. Over the years most of her clientele became friends instead of customers. Barb continued to cut and style hair from her home until only recently in 2020 when she made the move to Maple View Retirement Residence.

Barb was a faithful member of Norwood's St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church where she sang in the church choir for more than 60 years; she will be remembered by many for her wonderful voice.

From an early age Barb had a soft spot for her fur babies and it can be said that she never met a dog that she didn't like, especially Bandit her beloved Husky.

One of her greatest attributes was her concern for others and her greatest joy came from helping others in whatever way she could, a nicer person you will never meet.
