



Clayton Blair Popoff

June 26, 1959 - December 13, 2025

Clayton Blair Popoff, born June 26, 1959 in Rosthern, Saskatchewan, passed away on December 13, 2025 in Peterborough, Ontario, at the age of 66.

Clayton was raised in the Blaine Lake area and worked throughout his life in the trades as a bricklayer. In his youth, he had artistic interests, including painting. He also enjoyed cooking and maintained lifelong creative pursuits. He carried a charismatic and complex personality. He was of Doukhorbor heritage and remained connected to the history and community of the Blaine Lake region. His sister, Brenda Cheveldayoff, preserves a National Historic Site in Saskatchewan dedicated to that legacy.

Clayton is survived by his mother, Norma Joan Blanchard of Saskatoon; his children, Amanda Rohr of Florida and Blair Hartwig of British Columbia; seven grandchildren—Angela, Elizabeth, Mary, Charles, Jonathan, Christine, and Leo; and one great-grandchild, Aiden. He is also survived by his siblings, Lynda Favreau, Brenda Cheveldayoff, and Lyle Popoff. Clayton was predeceased by his father, Samuel James Popoff (d. November 1, 2001).

A graveside service will be held on March 28, 2026 at 1:00 p.m. at Oспенia Cemetery in Blaine Lake, Saskatchewan, where he will be laid to rest among his ancestors and the familiar fields of his early life.

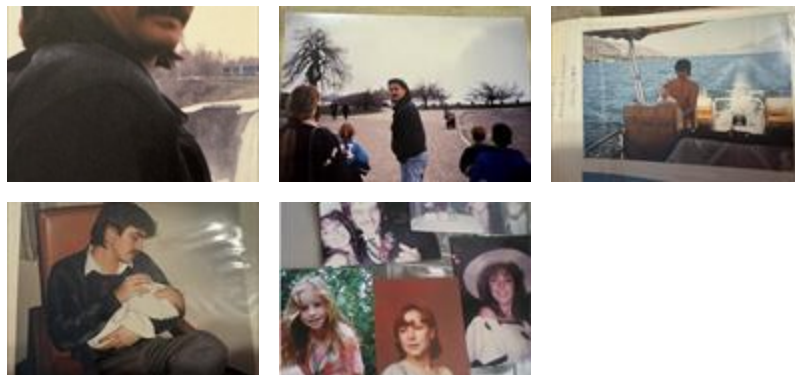


Rest now, dear brother, in the eternal, golden light of a late summer afternoon. May your peace be as deep and as lasting as the memory of your soul.
