It is with heavy hearts that the family of Gary Edward Niziol announces his passing on Sunday, June 14, 2026, at Peterborough Regional Health Centre. Gary leaves behind his loving children, Braeden and Tegan (Cole), and was the proud grandfather of Atticus and Emmett.

A man of great skill and resourcefulness, Gary was dedicated to his trade. After completing his commercial deep sea diving certification at Divers Training Academy in Florida, and welding specialist certification at Geroge Brown College, he started and ran his own small business, G. Niziol Welding Inspection & Diving Services. In addition to these pursuits, he spent over 40 years working at Cameco Corporation as a welder/fitter, non-destructive testing technician, and lab technician. Gary had a drive for fixing and building; if a project needed making or modifying—whether for his home, his hobbies, or his children—Gary’s first instinct was often to reach for his welding torch and other tools. He was a man who preferred to build and repair rather than purchase and replace, and he was always ready to put his skills to good use for the people he cared about.

Outside of his work, Gary took immense pride in meticulously maintaining his property, vehicles, and boats. He found peace out on the water while boating, and was a long-standing, dedicated member of the Northumberland Pistol and Revolver Club. He spent many fulfilling hours shooting at the range, as well as

training others in the sport.
