She welcomed newcomers to the neighbourhood as well as new ministers to her church with baked goods or an invite for Sunday dinner. Her address books were full of friends and acquaintances from over the years and was a dedicated letter writer to all (Canada Post will miss her!).

Missing her greatly are those she leaves behind; her brother Garth (Lucy) Dunham and children Ron (Gail) Hosler, Laurel (Joseph) Halliwushka, and the late Barry (surviving wife Cathy).
