Victor Alphonse Gendron of Sudbury, Toronto and Okeechobee Florida passed away on November 10, 2024 at the age of 96 after a long life searching for knowledge and his love of history, politics and jazz.

Vic was born on December 10, 1927 in Sudbury, Ontario. Vic was the eldest of six children of Georgina Mallette and Rheaume Gendron. As a young man in Sudbury, Vic spent several years in the seminary before leaving school for a travelling sales position and running the Larder Lake Hotel in Larder Lake, Ontario.

Vic met his wife Juliette Duguay in a chance encounter while both were on a trip to Toronto in 1952. While walking down Yonge Street, he recognized Juliette "as a girl from Sudbury" and though he was never a very forward person he spoke to her. They went for some drinks at the Brown Derby and that was the beginning of the story of the family they would build together.

They were married less than a year later. They were blessed with four wonderful children and seven grandchildren. Vic and Julie's romance lasted 30 years until she passed away from cancer in 1982.

Victor was predeceased by his father, Rheaume Gendron and mother, Georgina Mallette, sisters Jeanine, Theresa and Pauline, wife Juliette Duguay and son Victor Jr. He is survived by his daughters Jacqueline and Monique and his son Wayne; his eight grandchildren Chadwick, Natalie, Rene, Jesse, Dillon, Kylie and Kelsey; his great-grandchildren Kate, Holden, June, Molly, Reina, Lenyn, Theodora, Stevie and two more on the way; as well as his
